RECYCLE YOUR BOAT SHRINK WRAP

We invite you to join marinas, boat dealers, & individuals across the state to participate.

WHY RECYCLE BOAT SHRINK WRAP?

- For every bag recycled energy, oil, and landfill space is conserved.
- Save money on disposal fees.
- · Looks great on a Clean Marina application or recertification.
- Keeps the Great Lakes clean and waste free.

HOW DO I PARTICIPATE?

- Buy your EZ Fill Recycle Run bags at http://tinyurl.com/2aa2pmkb
 The purchase of your recycling bag covers pick-up, haul-away, and processing directly from your location.
- 2. Register for the program. Registration will open in early 2025. You can find the registration form by scanning the QR code to the left.
- 3. For direct pick-up of your boat shrink wrap you must register for a minimum of 15 bags. Locations in the UP must meet a 70 bag minimum.
- 4. Bags are industrial size and can hold shrink wrap up to a 32' boat (*1large wrap*) or (*1-3 small wraps*).
- 5. Each bag comes with a zip tie to seal the bag, and recycling instructions.
- 6. Program Coordinators will reach out to schedule a pick-up with your location in June August.



RECYCLING FOR INDIVIDUAL BOATERS

- If registering with less than 15 boat shrink wraps, you will be required to drop-off bags at a participating drop-off location. Visit our website or join our email list to learn more about Recycle Run drop-offs.
- We ask individuals to bundle bags tightly and keep them dry and clean as they plan for recycling in the spring.
