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RECYCLE YOUR BOAT SHRINK WRAP

We invite you to join marinas, boat dealers, & individuals across the state to participate.

BY RECYCLING BOAT SHRINK WRAP, YOUR BUSINESS WILL...

- Conserve energy, oil, and landfill space with every bag recycled.
- Save money on disposal fees while keeping the Great Lakes clean.
- Bolster your Clean Marina application or recertification.
- Get featured on our webpage listing marinas that actively recycle shrink wrap for two or more years in a row.

HOW DO I PARTICIPATE?

- Learn about the program and register by scanning the QR code on the left. Registration opens on January 15, 2026 and closes on June 1st.
- Buy EZ-Fill Recycle Run bags at <http://tinyurl.com/2aa2pmkb>. The purchase of bags covers the cost for pick-up, haul-away, and recycling of the material.
- Each bag is industrial-sized, and can fit 800 sq. ft. of plastic, a.k.a. the wrap from one 32 foot boat or 1-3 small wraps.
- If you fill 15 or more bags, we'll pick them up for no additional cost! Locations in the U.P. must fill at least 70 bags. If you're eligible for a pick-up, we'll reach out after registration closes in June.
- Please note the recycling instructions included with each bag. Failure to remove contaminants, like buckles and straps, could render the materials unrecyclable.



RECYCLING FOR INDIVIDUAL BOATERS

- Only unwrapping one or two boats? Any recycler filling less than 15 bags must bring them to a drop-off site, which are located around the state. See the registration form or our website for more details.
- We ask individuals to bundle bags tightly and keep them dry and clean as they plan for recycling in the spring.
- Share this flyer with your boating friends to help them keep the Great Lakes clean!
